day job to get me through the week end Well

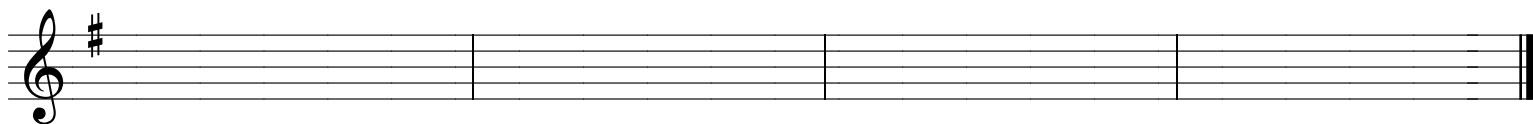
Verse 1
